We wish all our families and whānau a safe and happy Christmas and look forward to seeing you all again in the new year.

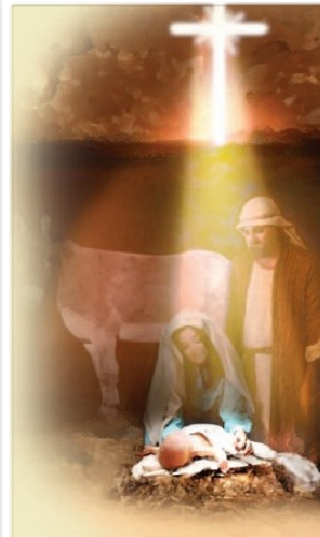




From the Bible:
