## Communities of Learning/Kāhui Ako

Hope Preschool has become a member of the Eastern Southland Kāhui Ako, along with 5 other local early childhood services. There are 11 primary schools and 2 secondary schools in this Community of Learning. We have made this step as we believe that it will benefit each child's learning because:

- Children and young people benefit when teachers across their learning pathways share practice expertise and increase their teaching capability.
- Communities of Learning | Kāhui Ako are an opportunity for early learning services and schools to work collaboratively to improve education outcomes for all learners.
- Including early learning expertise in a Community of Learning | Kāhui Ako can help make transition to school as seamless as possible.
- Strong early learning foundations support the whole learning pathway.
- Participation in Communities of Learning | Kāhui Ako is likely to be beneficial for early learning services over time, with shared resource availability and more direct information sharing.
